Isaiah 53: 10–12

1. He became the substitute sacrifice for sin
2. He produces many offspring, righteous believers
3. He prolonged His days:
Arose to carry on
and advance God's work
4. He conquered death
and brought satisfaction
to everyone involved
5. He justified many:
By bearing their iniquities
6. He is honoured as the great Victor:
He will divide the wealth of
His conquests with the strong
(believers)
 - a. Because He died as a transgressor
 - b. Because He bore the sin of many
 - c. Because He made intercession
for sinners

10 Yet it was the LORD's will to crush him
and cause him to suffer,
and though the LORD
makes his life an offering for sin,
he will see his offspring and prolong his days,
and the will of the LORD will prosper
in his hand.

11 After he has suffered,
he will see the light of life and be satisfied ;
by his knowledge
my righteous servant will justify many,
and he will bear their iniquities.

12 Therefore I will give him a portion
among the great,
and he will divide the spoils with the strong,
because he poured out his life unto death,
and was numbered with the transgressors.
For he bore the sin of many,
and made intercession for the transgressors.
