1 Step 1:

Peace comes through standing firm

- a. The source of strength: Being "in the Lord"
- b. The encouragement: A "brother" who cares

2 Step 2:

Peace comes through agreement and unity

- a. The plea: For arguers to agree in the Lord
- b. The need:
 The help of a true friend
 - 1) Must help them because they were co-labourers
 - 2) Must help them because their names are in the Book of Life

3 Step 3:

Peace comes through rejoicing continually and repeatedly

4 Step 4:
Peace comes
thrrough a strong gentleness

- 1 Therefore, my brothers, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, that is how you should stand firm in the Lord, dear friends!
- 2 I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to agree with each other in the Lord.
- 3 Yes, and I ask you, loyal yokefellow, help these women who have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life.
- 4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
- 5 Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.
