  - d. Shut the mouths of lions
  - e. Quenched fire
  - f. Escaped the sword
  - g. Brought strength out of weakness
  - h. Grew powerful in battle

- 32 And what more shall I say?
  I do not have time to tell about Gideon,
  Barak, Samson and Jephthah,
  about David and Samuel and the prophets,
- 33 who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, and gained what was promised; who shut the mouths of lions.
- 34 quenched the fury of the flames, and escaped the edge of the sword; whose weakness was turned to strength; and who became powerful in battle and routed foreign armies.
