## The Great Believers' Faith (Part I): A Heroic Faith Hebrews 11:32-34

- 1 The heroic faith of outstanding leaders: A faith that accepted incredible responsibility and that called upon God for great courage
- 2 The reward of heroic faith
  - a. Conquered kingdoms
  - b. Ruled with justice
  - c. Obtained promises
  - d. Shut the mouths of lions
  - e. Quenched fire
  - f. Escaped the sword
  - g. Brought strength out of weakness
  - h. Grew powerful in battle

- 32 And what more shall I say?I do not have time to tell about Gideon,Barak, Samson and Jephthah,about David and Samuel and the prophets,
- 33 who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, and gained what was promised; who shut the mouths of lions,
- 34 quenched the fury of the flames, and escaped the edge of the sword; whose weakness was turned to strength; and who became powerful in battle and routed foreign armies.

## The Great Believers' Faith (Part II): An Enduring Faith Hebrews 11:35-40

- 1 There was the enduring faith of believers
  - a. Some women received their dead raised
  - b. Some were tortured
  - c. Some endured trials of mockery, scourging, chains, and imprisonment
  - d. Some were martyred
  - e. Some were treated in the most inhuman way imaginable

## 2 There was the reward of enduring faith

- a. God's approval and great historic witness
- b. The promised Seed or Messiah and the promised land

- 35 Women received back their dead, raised to life again.There were others who were tortured, refusing to be released so that they might gain an even better resurrection.
- 36 Some faced jeers and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment.
- 37 They were put to death by stoning; they were sawed in two; they were killed by the sword.
  They went about in sheepskins and goatskins, destitute, persecuted and mistreated —
- 38 the world was not worthy of them.They wandered in deserts and mountains, living in caves and in holes in the ground.
- 39 These were all commended for their faith, yet none of them received what had been promised,
- 40 since God had planned something better for us so that only together with us would they be made perfect.
