## The Great Believers' Faith (Part II): An Enduring Faith Hebrews 11:35-40

## 1 There was the enduring faith of believers

- a. Some women received their dead raised
- b. Some were tortured
- c. Some endured trials of mockery, scourging, chains, and imprisonment
- d. Some were martyred
- e. Some were treated in the most inhuman way imaginable

## 2 There was the reward of enduring faith

- a. God's approval and great historic witness
- b. The promised Seed or Messiah and the promised land

- 35 Women received back their dead, raised to life again.

  There were others who were tortured, refusing to be released so that they might gain an even better resurrection.
- 36 Some faced jeers and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment.
- 37 They were put to death by stoning; they were sawed in two; they were killed by the sword.

  They went about in sheepskins and goatskins, destitute, persecuted and mistreated —
- 38 the world was not worthy of them.

  They wandered in deserts and mountains, living in caves and in holes in the ground.
- 39 These were all commended for their faith, yet none of them received what had been promised,
- 40 since God had planned something better for us so that only together with us would they be made perfect.
