- 1) His blessing
- 2) His protection, security
- 3) His face, special presence
- 4) His grace
- 5) His acceptance, approval, pleasure (smile)
- 6) His peace
- b. The result:The blessings identifiedthe Israelites as God's people,as belonging to Him

- 21 "This is the law of the Nazirite who vows offerings to the LORD in accordance with their dedication, in addition to whatever else they can afford. They must fulfil the vows they have made, according to the law of the Nazirite."
- 22 The LORD said to Moses,
- 23 "Tell Aaron and his sons,
 'This is how you are to bless the Israelites.
 Say to them:
- 24 "The LORD bless you and keep you;
- 25 the LORD make his face shine on you and be gracious to you;
