

Noah and the Flood: God's Great Judgment of the Earth

Genesis 07: 10–24

1. *The great power of God in judgement*

- a. God's power had the traumatic day fixed
- b. God's power violently broke up the earth's crust and burst loose all the earth's subterranean waters
- c. God's power opened up the floodgates of heaven: A violent, torrential downpour for 40 days and nights

2. *The great salvation of God in judgement*

- a. Noah and his family went into the ark
- b. Every animal went into the ark
 - 1) Each kind or species of animal
 - 2) The animals went two by two to Noah
 - 3) One male and one female went in
- c. God Himself shut the door to the ark

10 And after the seven days the flood-waters came on the earth.

11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, on the seventeenth day of the second month — on that day all the springs of the great deep burst forth, and the floodgates of the heavens were opened.

12 And rain fell on the earth forty days and forty nights.

13 On that very day Noah and his sons, Shem, Ham and Japheth, together with his wife and the wives of his three sons, entered the ark.

14 They had with them every wild animal according to its kind, all livestock according to their kinds, every creature that moves along the ground according to its kind and every bird according to its kind, everything with wings.

15 Pairs of all creatures that have the breath of life in them came to Noah and entered the ark.

16 The animals going in were male and female of every living thing, as God had commanded Noah. Then the LORD shut him in.

**3. *The great fulfilment
of God's Word in judgment***

a. God flooded water upon
the earth for 40 days,
but bore up the ark

1) The waters increased greatly,
but the ark floated

2) The waters mightily rose
more and more until all
the mountains were covered

3) The waters mightily rose
to a height of 20 feet

b. God destroyed all life

1) All flesh perished,
both animal and man

2) Every living thing
upon dry land perished

3) Every living thing upon
the ground was wiped out

c. God saved Noah and all those
in the ark with him

**4. *The great time that the water
flooded the earth in judgment***

17 For forty days
the flood kept coming on the earth,
and as the waters increased
they lifted the ark high above the earth.

18 The waters rose and increased greatly
on the earth,
and the ark floated
on the surface of the water.

19 They rose greatly on the earth,
and all the high mountains
under the entire heavens were covered.

20 The waters rose and covered the mountains
to a depth of more than fifteen cubits.

21 Every living thing that moved on land
perished — birds, livestock, wild animals,
all the creatures that swarm over the earth,
and all mankind.

22 Everything on dry land
that had the breath of life in its nostrils died.

23 Every living thing on the face of the earth
was wiped out; people and animals
and the creatures that move along the ground
and the birds were wiped from the earth.
Only Noah was left,
and those with him in the ark.

24 The waters flooded the earth
for a hundred and fifty days.
