Deuteronomy 05: 16–21**

1. Commandment 5:

Man's parents

- a. The commandment:
Honour your father and mother
- b. The reasons
 - 1) Will live longer
 - 2) Will help things go better —
far better: Live a victorious life

16 “Honour your father and your mother,
as the LORD your God has commanded you,
so that you may live long
and that it may go well with you
in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

2. Commandment 6:

Man's life

17 “You shall not murder.

3. Commandment 7:

Man's family; Forbids adultery

18 “You shall not commit adultery.

4. Commandment 8:

Man's property

19 “You shall not steal.

5. Commandment 9:

***Man's word; Forbids lying or
speaking falsely against anyone***

20 “You shall not give false testimony
against your neighbour.”

6. Commandment 10:

***Man's desires and security:
Forbids coveting anything that
belongs to your neighbour —
his wife, house, land, servant,
animals or anything else***

21 “You shall not covet your neighbour's wife.
You shall not set your desire
on your neighbour's house or land,
his male or female servant,
his ox or donkey,
or anything that belongs to your neighbour.”
