The feasts: A reminder that Christ died to save us from sin and death and give us eternal life

- a. The New Year's Day Feast:
To purify the sanctuary
- 1) To offer a young bull
 - 2) To put some blood on...
 - The temple doorposts
 - The four corners of the altar's middle (upper) ledge
 - The gateposts of the inner court
 - 3) To do the same on the seventh day of the new year:
To celebrate the LORD's atoning sacrifice for all who sin unintentionally
- b. The Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread
- 1) The Passover: To observe on day 14 of the New Year
 - 2) The Feast of Unleavened Bread: To observe 7 days

18 "This is what the Sovereign LORD says:
'In the first month on the first day
you are to take a young bull without defect
and purify the sanctuary.

19 The priest is to take
some of the blood of the sin offering
and put it on the doorposts of the temple,
on the four corners
of the upper ledge of the altar
and on the gateposts of the inner court.

20 You are to do the same
on the seventh day of the month
for anyone who sins unintentionally
or through ignorance;
so you are to make atonement for the temple.

21 In the first month on the fourteenth day
you are to observe the Passover,
a festival lasting seven days,
during which you shall eat
bread made without yeast.

The Feast of Tabernacles: God's power to bring His people safely into the promised land. Lev 23:33-36</p> <p>1) To begin on the 15th day of month 7: To last 7 days</p> <p>2) To make the same offerings for Passover</p>	<p>22 On that day the prince is to provide a bull as a sin offering for himself and for all the people of the land.</p> <p>23 Every day during the seven days of the festival he is to provide seven bulls and seven rams without defect as a burnt offering to the LORD, and a male goat for a sin offering.</p> <p>24 He is to provide as a grain offering an ephah for each bull and an ephah for each ram, along with a hin of olive oil for each ephah.</p> <p>25 During the seven days of the festival, which begins in the seventh month on the fifteenth day, he is to make the same provision for sin offerings, burnt offerings, grain offerings and oil.' ”</p>
