

The Results of Obeying the Covenant: The Blessings of God Deuteronomy 28:01–14

1. *The blessings of God are conditional*

- a. Must obey the LORD
- b. The result of obedience

- 1) Will be exalted
- 2) Will experience all the blessings of God

- 3) Will be continually blessed — no matter where you are

2. *The blessing of fruitfulness*

- a. The fruitfulness of population growth
- b. The fruitfulness of livestock
- c. The fruitfulness of crops
- d. The fruitfulness of daily food

3. *The blessing of all daily activities*

4. *The blessing of victory over all enemies (Eph 6:10-18)*

5. *The blessing of labour, work, employment*

- a. The promise: God will bless all you put your hand to
- b. The result: Will experience purpose, achievement, accomplishment, fulfilment

1 If you fully obey the LORD your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations on earth.

2 All these blessings will come on you and accompany you if you obey the LORD your God:

3 You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country.

4 The fruit of your womb will be blessed, and the crops of your land and the young of your livestock — the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks.

5 Your basket and your kneading trough will be blessed.

6 You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out.

7 The LORD will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you. They will come at you from one direction but flee from you in seven.

8 The LORD will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hand to. The LORD your God will bless you in the land he is giving you.

6. <i>The blessing of spiritual growth</i> a. The promise: God will establish you as His holy people b. The condition: Must obey God c. The result: A strong testimony and witness for the Lord — the exaltation of the Lord's name 7. <i>The blessing of prosperity, an excess of good things</i> a. The good things such as children, livestock, crops b. The Lord will open the storehouse, the treasury, of His provision: Rain and a blessing upon all your works c. The blessing of a prosperous, wealthy economy 8. <i>The blessing of exaltation</i> a. The promise: Will become the head or leader, not the tail b. The condition: Must obey God c. The promise reemphasized: Will always be on top, not on bottom 9. <i>The strong charge: Do not turn away from any of the commandments to follow false gods or false worship</i>	9 The LORD will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in obedience to him. 10 Then all the peoples on earth will see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will fear you. 11 The LORD will grant you abundant prosperity — in the fruit of your womb, the young of your livestock and the crops of your ground — in the land he swore to your ancestors to give you. 12 The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none. 13 The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the LORD your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. 14 Do not turn aside from any of the commands I give you today, to the right or to the left, following other gods and serving them.
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
